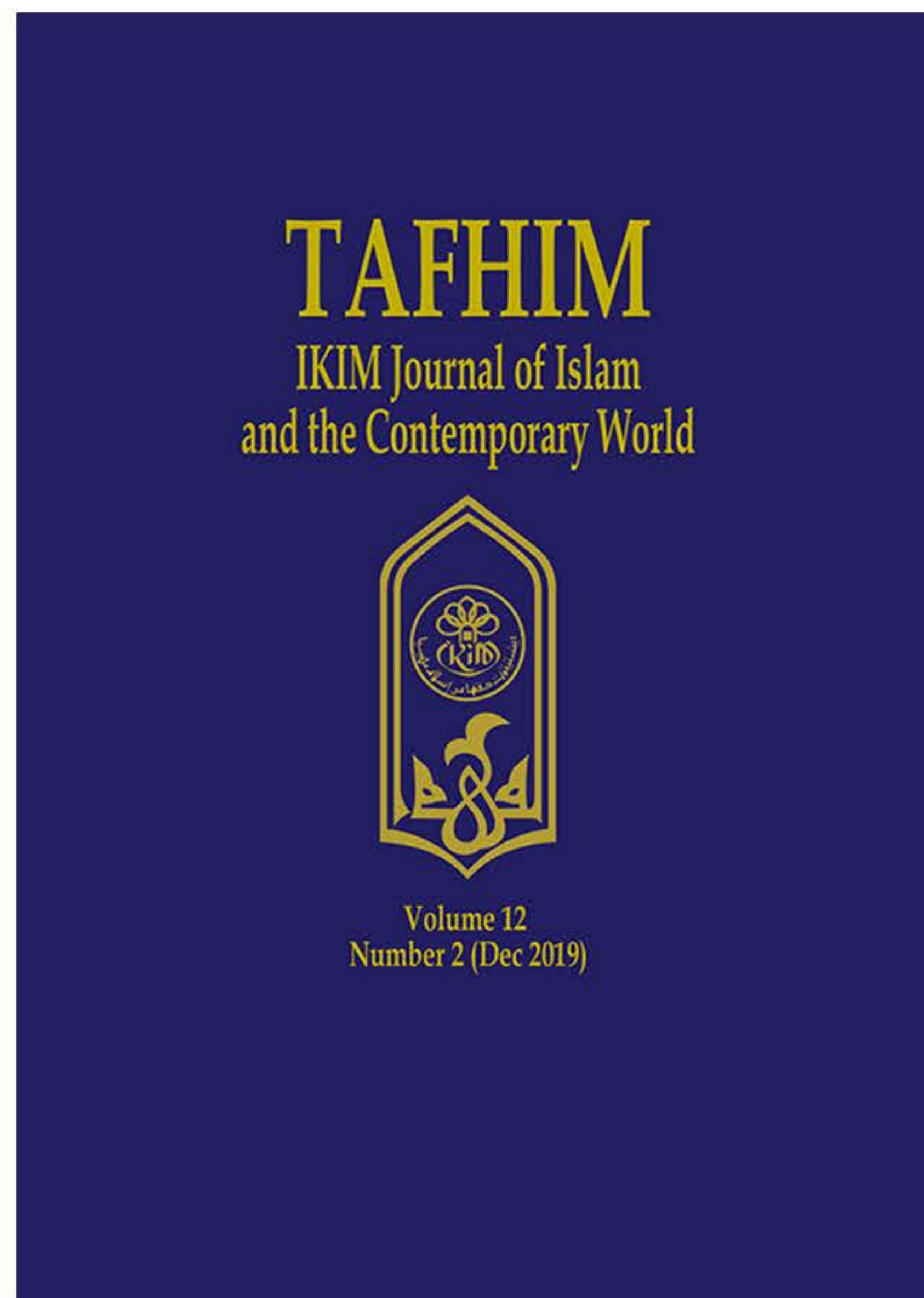

All manuscripts will be reviewed by the TAFHIM Editorial Board. With the exception of manuscripts by invited authors, they shall then be reviewed by at least one independent reviewer. Decision regarding the publication of a manuscript is based on assessment by the reviewer(s).

Although TAFHIM editors are responsible for the selection and acceptance of the articles and reserve the right to edit manuscripts as deemed appropriate, responsibility for opinions expressed in them rests solely with the individual authors. The copyright of any article published in TAFHIM belongs to IKIM; however, it can be reprinted with proper acknowledgement of its prior publication herein.

## GUIDANCE FOR SUBMISSION

- ▀ Articles submitted must be original contributions and have not been previously published or under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- ▀ Author's full name (in the form preferred for publication), university or professional affiliation, as well as complete postal address, e-mail and telephone number where the author can be reached should be included.
- ▀ Use of diacritics for transliteration must follow the system and method outlined in the Transliteration Table which can be accessed at [https://tafhim.ikim.gov.my/file\\_upload/trans.pdf](https://tafhim.ikim.gov.my/file_upload/trans.pdf)

- ▀ The TAFHIM Editorial Board may invite an erudite scholar or a professional to write an article in his/her field of expertise. The format of the invited article must follow the standard specified by TAFHIM, and must be an original article which has not been published elsewhere. Suitability for publication will be determined by the TAFHIM Editorial Board.
- ▀ In the event of doubt, reference should be made to *The Chicago Manual of Style* or Turabian's *A Manual for Writers*.
